What is the American Indian Advisory Council?

LIBERTY Dental Plan's (LIBERTY's) American Indian Advisory
Council will assist the Quality Management and Improvement
Committee (QMIC) in fulfilling its oversight responsibilities for
matters relating to operations, public policy, member
satisfaction, and delivery of oral health and dental care services
for Oklahoma's American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN)
communities.

American Indian Advisory Council Responsibilities:

- Assist in strengthening partnerships with Tribes, Tribal Dental Care Providers, AI/AN Members, and community stakeholders to help ensure the AI/AN enrollees and Native communities' oral health needs are well represented.
- Support the exchange of information and provide recommendations on policy issues and strategies like access to care, care delivery, and outreach efforts. LIBERTY strives to connect with its members through feedback and experiences to improve oral health and access to the AI/AN communities.

Meeting Details:

- Meetings are held quarterly.
- Council members will receive a \$100 honorarium for participating in each meeting.
- A tablet will be provided for Council members to participate in meetings and access meeting materials. The tablet will be provided in lieu of the first meeting's honorarium.
